4. To ensure effective teaching and learning process, it is decided to group the students into two batches for the 2nd year and 4th year students respectively. The Coordinator of the Program is requested to organize the Schedules consistent with this policy.
5. It is resolved to arrange an Office Assistant to look after the office work like typing, maintenance of files, records and ensuring timely cooperation of the Coordinators in the Academic Departments of the college. Hence, it is recommended to appoint Office Assistants at an allowance of Rs.8000 per month..


