


The ongoing programs of strengthening the all-round development of the Students, the College envisages a well-drawn student support system consisting of:

Report of Stages in Thinking and Types of Thinking

A Three day workshop on "Stages in Thinking and Types of Thinking " was organized by skill development and personality development center, JITS from 2nd to 4th December 2019 for B.Tech 2nd ,3rd and 4th year students at 4.00pm to 6.00pm. **Prof M.Vani Manohar** being the resource conducted Seminar on the first day. He explained the meaning and concept of 'Thinking'. As long as the heart beat continues the process of 'thinking' will persist. In this program 63 students have attended and noted the points in their note book to much of their interest. In his talk "Prof M.Vani **Manohar**" has given a lot of basic information on Thinking beyond Limits – Need for it in Career Building, Stages in Thinking and Types of Thinking. In the second day of the workshop, he gave Exercises in Thinking beyond limits. He told that He impressed on the participants about the thinking as a 'process of reasoning about something. According to him, a thinker is a person of rational judgment and There are many types of thinking like; critical thinking, divergent thinking, creative, convergent thinking, analytical, abstract and positive. A person with positive thinking will emerge as a peak performer because he always immerse in doing something good even to his enemy. On the final day of the Workshop, Prof. Vanimanhoar conducted a game with some placards. Judging the nature of thinking is not easy, according to the resource person, till the results are obtained and analyzed. He tested the thinking process of a few participants by giving a brief sketch of an event and asked them to speak differently from one another. Ultimately, thinking beyond may mean, (a) thinking beyond self; (b) thinking beyond the box, (c) thinking beyond imagination, (d) thinking beyond 'quotes' and (f) thinking beyond interiors. The three day workshop was wound up with the Vote of Thanks by Prof. G. Krishna Murthy, Coordinator of the SPDP Center.
