

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Report of Listening Skills – Significance in Communication

A **Three day workshop** on “Listening Skills – Significance in Communication” was organized by Skill and Personality Development center (SPDPC), JITS from 16th to 18th December 2019 for B.Tech 2nd, 3rd and 4th year students from 4.00 pm to 6.00 pm. **Prof. Ghanshyam Singh**, Dept. of ECE, JITS being the resource person explained about the significance of listening. He said that skillful listening is the pre-requisite of effective communication. In this program 63 students have attended and noted the points in their note book to much of their interest. In the first day of the Workshop, “**Prof. Ghanshyam Singh**” has given a lot of basic information about Listening Skills and its Significance in Communication, Types of Communication and their application. He demonstrated that listening is different from hearing, though they are similar by meaning. He said that listening enhances the ability to understand better to make better communication. Good listening makes the experience of speaking to the enjoyment of others. He explained that there are 7 types of listening. They are: (i) informational listening, (ii) Discriminative listening, (iii) Biased listening, (iv) Sympathetic listening, (v) Comprehensive listening, (vi) Empathetic listening and critical listening. These listening skills will certainly change the lives of the people. An effective listener will enjoying communication with his recipient. On the 2nd day of the Workshop, he illustrated the most important communication skills. They are: (a) written communication, (b) oral communication, (c) visual communication, (d) active communication reflected by body language, and (e) contextual communication. On the third day of Workshop, Prof. Singh has shown video clips and tested the listening skills of the handpicked students. He also emphasized listening and communication are important for employer and employees to solve the problems to the satisfaction of both the parties. The workshop was wound up with a few remarks by the participants. One of the participants proposed vote of thanks.




