The Anti-Ragging Cell is requested to oversee the discipline in the college particularly to safe guard the freshly admitted first year students. The following are the guide lines for the committee to maintain discipline and prevent anti-ragging.

- Students are expected to possess a sense of belonging and have respect for the property of the Institute and Individuals. Any student found intentionally damaging **Institutional Assets** like fixtures, equipment, instruments, furniture, books, buildings, vehicles etc., and / or individual property is liable for severe punishment including expulsion.
- Smoking and chewing Pan/Ghutka in the campus is not permitted. Use of alcoholic drinks, within the
 premises of the institute is strictly prohibited. The students must abstain from the use of drugs or any
 other narcotics.
- Every student must abide by the rules and regulations framed by the Institute from time to time. Every student will be issued personal identity card for one academic year and he/she should carry the same at all times. Students are expected to be courteous and friendly with the faculty, staff and other students of the institute.

- Every student must be punctual and regular in attending all classes and seasonal tests. Students are
 expected to join NSS and NCC and participate in games, sports, cultural and other co-curricular
 activities.
- If any student found or indulging ragging, the committee has to take it seriously and award punishment to the students after due enquiry.
- All anti-ragging cases must be reported immediately to the police along with the charge-sheet and
 immediately the students indulging in ragging shall be suspended until completion of enquiry. If found
 guilty they may be expelled from the college after giving TC and No conduct Certificate.

The punishment to be given to the students indulging the ragging as per the anti ragging rules of Government of Telangana are the following:

A few rules are given below:

Action	Punishment
* Testing, embarrassing or forces or criminally intimidating a student.	Imprisonment up to the extent of 6 months or fine up to a max of Rs. 1,000/- or both.
* Assaulting or using criminal forces or criminally intimidating a student.	Imprisonment up to 1 year or fine up to Rs. 2,000/- or both.
* Wrongfully restraining or confining or causing hurt to a student.	Imprisonment up to a term of 2 years or fine up to Rs. 5,000/- or both.
* Causing hurt to or kidnapping or raping or committing unnatural offence to a student.	Imprisonment up to a term of 2 years or fine up to Rs. 10,000/- or both.
* Causing death or abetting suicide.	Imprisonment for a term extending up to 10 years and fine extending up to Rs. 50,000/
